



Camper Code of Conduct 2021

This code is in effect from the 07 day of May, 2021.

Campers,

Silver Lake Tent and Trailer Park welcomes you back! Please read this Code of Conduct (the Code) and review it with all family members. The rules in this Code must be followed to ensure we all stay safe and do not engage in activities that contravene any Provincial or Federal Government regulations and ensure we comply with all health regulations. It is important to remember that, ultimately, we are all in charge of our own health and safety. Please remember to bring a mask and gloves or hand sanitizer for the occasion that you will need it.

This Code is over and above our normal campground rules, which still apply. Strict enforcement of all rules will be in place for all registered names on your occupancy agreement. Any camper, regardless of age who breaches this Code will be asked to leave the campground immediately and your Licence of Occupation will be cancelled immediately.

Follow the SCREENING TOOL before entering the park. If you have tested positive for COVID-19, are a presumptive case, or have been in contact with anyone who has tested positive or is a presumptive case, we request that you do not attempt to enter the campground. Please remain at your residence until you have been cleared by your local health department and/or you have finished your self-isolation of 14 days. If you are returning from travel from outside of the Province of Ontario, do not plan to visit the campground for a period of 14 days, please remain home. Follow this form. You will see this form at the entrance, on our fb page and around camp.

COVID-19 Screening Requirements

If you answer "Yes" to any of the following questions, do not enter the premises.

Do you have one or more of the COVID-19 symptoms below?

• Fever and/or chills	• Decrease or loss of taste or smell	• Sore throat (for adults only)
• Cough or hacking cough (ongoing)	• Heavy or watery conjunctival (eye) discharge	• Fatigue (not just tired)
• Shortness of breath	• Loss of voice (hoarseness)	• Diarrhoea
• Sore throat	• Unusual loss of smell or taste	• Rash (not on face)
• Flu-like symptoms	• Headaches	

Has a doctor, health care provider, or public health unit told you that you should currently be isolating (staying at home)?

Have you been identified as a "close contact" of someone who currently has COVID-19 in the last 14 days?

Have you received a COVID Alert exposure notification on your cell phone in the last 14 days (and have not been tested or waiting for your result)?

Have you or anyone you live with traveled outside of Canada in the last 14 days?

At this time, we will be operating under the following rules. These rules may change as the Ontario or Federal Government amends legislation. Changes will be made on our FB page as they come.

Visitors

Visitors allowed in the campground depend on the colour of the Region. The colour may change from time to time and may be different from the region you live in. If you have questions, please consult the campground.

GREY LOCKDOWN	No visitors allowed in the campground. Just your family on seasonal contract should be on your site.
RED - CONTROL	No visitors in the campground. Just your family on seasonal contract should be on your site.
ORANGE- RESTRICT	Visitors allowed. A Max. of 10 people total on your site. Masks must be worn if you cannot socially distance. NO one should be in trailer but those on your seasonal contract. No overnight guests. Please respect the rules of the campground regarding number of visitors. Visitors must provide their name and contact information by filling out the online waiver. Guest must be off campground property by 10 pm.
YELLOW - PROTECT	Visitors allowed. A Max. of 10 people total on your site. Masks must be worn if you cannot socially distance. NO one should be in trailer but those on your seasonal contract. No overnight guests. Please respect the rules of the campground regarding number of visitors. Visitors must provide their name and contact information by filling out the online waiver. Guests must be off property by 10 pm.
GREEN - PREVENT	Visitors allowed. A Max. of 10 people total on your site. Masks must be worn if you cannot socially distance. Family may stay the night. Visitors must provide their name and contact information by filling out the online waiver. Other visitors not staying night must be off property by 10 pm.

Updates will be posted on facebook regarding visitors and zones when the time comes. Any visitors that do not fill out online waiver will be asked to leave and not return. Visitors must be planned, they can not just show up.

Common Areas

The following common areas are closed until further notice. All areas that are closed are indicated with a sign. If you are unsure whether something is closed or not, please contact the office for clarification. At this time:

- Washrooms are closed
- Boathouse is closed
- Park is use at your own risk, equipment in park is not sanitized.
- Worms and Ice will be on an honorary system. We are hoping to have an outdoor fridge and freezer. Use at your own risk.
- Hand sanitizer will be place outside main washroom building and small bathroom.

Walking around the Campground

At all times campers must obey social distancing rules and gathering laws as mandated by the Province of Ontario. You must stay 2 meters or 6 feet away from other campers. You may use walking trails if social distancing rules are followed.

Children

We expect that all parents will ensure their children always obey the rules. If your children cannot follow these rules, please do not bring them to the campground at this time. Children should be accompanied by an adult at all time when off-site. This includes activities such as bicycling and walking.

Golf Carts

Only the registered owner may be permitted in the cart. You must have insurance and a valid licence.

Limit of campers in an area

Campers are expected to follow the Social distancing and gathering rules.

Office/Store

- The office is closed until further notice. Please use electronic e-transfers for payment or cheques. Alternatively, we have set up a mailbox outside of the office please use it for cheques and any other correspondence.
If you have made arrangements to come into the office, please wear a mask and practice social distancing. If you need to sign any documentation, please bring your own pen. All forms are digital so can be done on cell phone or computer, we would prefer this. Do not send money without sending your contract first so office can go over it, to make sure it is correct. All forms must be signed before you can enter campground for the 2021 season.

Respect of others and staff

All Customers, guests and staff are responsible for respecting the dignity and rights of everyone at the campground. Every person has a right to expect their time at the campground will be without any type of discrimination or harassment.
